Ojai Day 2022 Launches with Local Poster Competition

OJAI, CA (May 30, 2022) Applications are available now through June 30, 2022, for Ojai Valley residents wishing to submit art for the official Ojai Day 2022 poster. The competition is open to artists of all ages, and limited to individuals living in the Ojai Valley. The selected artist will receive a \$200 stipend and City Council recognition: Their poster will promote Ojai Day 2022 throughout the region and become part of the City's historical archives.

Ojai Day 2022 is a locally infused celebration of arts, entertainment and fun that is returning to Libbey Park on Saturday, October 15, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. The first Ojai Day took place in 1917 and ran annually until 1928. Since its revival in 1991, Ojai Valley residents have created the poster for Ojai Day, contributing to local history along the way.

Artists may provide up to three pieces of original artwork for judging. The finished product must be reproduction-compatible and submitted in color on an 11 by 17-inch template. A jury of local artists and art-lovers will review all submissions and select a final poster. View the [online application](#) and the contest rules at [ojaiday/poster](#).
